## MOUNTED OBSTACLE CHALLENGE RESERVATION

Mounted Obstacle Challenge Wednesday, August 16th starting at 10:00 a.m.

If you like the challenge of running an obstacle course with unique challenges, you will love this event. You & your horse will navigate the course for points to determine how well you can master the obstacles encountered as an individual or in pairs. Come out & have some fun! This is a low key event with points earned by task completion based on number of attempts, not perfection & proficiency. No classes for ages or gender. Placings & awards 1st - 5th places.

Must submit a current negative coggins for each horse. Must be kept in barn to be eligible to show. Class registration can be sent with stall reservations or register upon arrival. Horses should be in place by 6 p.m. on Tuesday, August 15th. Release time is 8 p.m. on Wednesday, August 16th. Those that wish to stay remaining horse shows may do so, but may be reassigned to a different stall. Horses must be ridden with a western saddle, no tie downs or martingales may be used. Riders must wear a western hat or helmet, western boots, collared shirt, t-shirt, short or long-sleeved. Spurs optional. Class fee is \$5 - no stall fee. Animal may be used twice by different riders, for individual course, or twice by the same rider (example; once individual/once pairs)
